Introduction

Degens and Dragons[®] is a tournament-style battle game that runs on the Sui network, using a set of specially-developed smart contracts to enable players to buy NFT game pieces (degens) and use them to compete in a global contest of skill. Degens and Dragons[®] is proprietary to Orange Comet, Inc. (referred to herein as “OC”, “we”, “us”, or “our”). OC respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website <https://degensdragonsgame.com> and/or its associated social media channels, and the data, services, information, tools, functionality, updates and similar materials (collectively, our “Website”), and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:
